

Grand Haven Christian School Tuition Reduction Incentive Program – TRIP General Policies

PURPOSE

The families of GHCS have an opportunity to reduce their tuition through the Tuition Reduction Incentive Program (TRIP). Through TRIP, gift cards and certificates are purchased from participating food and retail stores at a discount. These gift cards are sold at face value to families who participate in the program. The discount or credit that is earned by TRIP is passed on to the families registered to participate in the program in the form of tuition credit.

PROGRAM POLICIES

- 1) TRIP will run weekly during the school year except for normally scheduled school vacations. A summer schedule is published in the Home Bulletin in May and will be posted under Announcements on shopwithscrip.com.
- 2) The account name on your order shall be the same as the family name on your tuition statement.
- 3) Family or friends may help with tuition reduction by registering and recording the designated family to be helped with their rebates. The name on the order form must be a registered name in order to be processed. Tuition earnings may also be directed to the Financial Assistance Fund of GHCS.
- 4) Parents looking to the future and planning for Christian education at GHCS may also participate. This is referred to as our Future Families Program.
- 5) All gift card orders must be accompanied by a **check** made payable to GHCS-TRIP or paid for on line with PrestoPay. These payments are non-tax deductible as participants receive face value for all purchases.
- 6) The percentage earned on each participating family's account will be held by TRIP and credited to its tuition account two times a year (October and May). Tuition credits will be posted to RenWeb at that time. Any questions regarding TRIP credits must be brought to the attention of the TRIP coordinator within 45 days of the distribution date.
- 7) TRIP is being offered primarily to promote the education of students at GHCS; however, if your children no longer attend GHCS, the money held under your account number can be:
 - credited to your outstanding tuition
 - credited to another family's tuition account at GHCS
 - credited to the Financial Assistance Fund
 - credited to your account at Western Michigan Christian High School

In some instances (move from the area, etc.), credits can be transferred to a tuition account at another Christian School. Written notice of where the funds are to be credited must be received within 60 days of leaving GHCS; otherwise the funds will be transferred to the Financial Assistance Fund.

- 8) All completed orders (with payment) are due on Mondays by 8:00 AM. Late orders will be held for the next week's processing. It is not necessary to place an order every week. Paper orders can be dropped off anytime during the week in the TRIP box by the office or in the locked mailbox outside the front doors of the school before or after school hours.
- 9) Orders may be placed on line at shopwithscrip.com. These orders can be paid for by check made out to GHCS – TRIP and delivered to the school or via the PrestoPay payment option offered at the shopwithscrip.com website. Weekly ordering deadlines for on line orders shall be the same as for paper orders. Ordering on line provides a multitude of benefits ranging from increased availability of nationwide vendors, ScripNow! (immediate eCertificates), reloading of previously purchased gift cards, and more. Grand Haven Christian School's on line enrollment code is 71L9397L145. Please contact the TRIP Coordinator if you currently use TRIP and would like to begin on line purchases; this will enable your current TRIP account to be linked with your on line purchases.

- 10) Order Pick -Up
 - a. **Child:** A disclaimer of responsibility form must be signed for each school year before the gift cards will be released to a child.
 - b. **Mail:** Provide a business size, self-addressed stamped envelope for mailing purposes. It must be large enough and have adequate postage for the order.
 - c. **Office: (Preferred)** Filled orders will be available by 9:30 AM each Monday and shall be released with a signature.

- 11) The gift cards are the same as cash. Neither GHCS nor TRIP will accept responsibility for lost or misplaced gift cards. This includes those mailed.

- 12) TRIP credit is now available for all tuition at GHCS; this includes preschool through 8th grade.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE IN GHCS-TRIP?

Pick up a registration form, fill it out and return it to school. Once registered, there are three basic ways to order: Check and Carry Forms from the office, Long Form Orders, and ordering on line at shopwithscrip.com. There is no minimum order and you do not have to participate on a weekly basis.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GHCS purchases certificates and gift cards from various stores through an organization called GREAT LAKES SCRIP. The percentage of credit earned varies among suppliers. GHCS-TRIP will retain a net 1% of purchases for program operation expenses and the Financial Assistance Fund.

Example:	Five Leppinks \$20 gift cards ordered:	\$100.00
	Payment to GHCS-TRIP	\$100.00
	School's purchase discount – 5%	\$ 5.00
	Operations expenses – 1%	\$ 1.00
	Family tuition credit – 4%	\$ 4.00

Other notes: Some families prefer to use store credit cards. Kohls is one retailer that accepts TRIP cards as payment on charge accounts; please check with other retailers prior to purchasing TRIP.
